Dr Andrij Baumketner spent several time with our group of computational physics at the Department of Computational Science, Faculty of Science and the Graduate School of Natural Science and Technology, Kanazawa University, Japan while he was employed by the JST and Kanazawa University from October 2000 to March 2002.
