I have known Dr. Wellmer since late 1999, when he arrived to the California Institute of Technology to work as a Postdoctoral Scholar in the laboratory of Dr. Elliot Meyerowitz. At the time, I was working in Industry (Senior Scientist at Mendel Biotechnology, Inc.), but was also starting to collaborate with Prof. Meyerowitz to initiate in his laboratory a DNA microarray program to study Arabidopsis flower development. Dr. Wellmer was the first person to join that team, and was really critical for the success of our efforts.
