

The foundation










Finishing your structure







Cedar Upgrade

Our interior bunkie upgrade is perfect for those looking to be completely surrounded by nature. It includes a floor that's been upgraded from the standard plywood to a T&rG 1 x 6 pine, 2 x 4 cedar wall studs (instead of spruce) and 1x 6 cedar roof boards that keep a roof over your head and the aroma of cedar in the air.





Drawings and Permits

In most jurisdictions, building permits are not required for structures under 100 sq. ft. Once you're over 100 sq. ft., a permit may be required. All Summerwood structures exceeding 100 sq. ft. are manufactured to conform to the most rigid of building codes, however we are talking government here and some codes have odd stipulations. Should a slight modification be required to conform to your local guideline, we will be pleased to make that change for you (a small charge may apply.) If you require a permit drawing and specifications, we will be pleased to provide it for you at the time of your order.






A SLOWER PLACE


Summerwood western red cedar gazebos are designed with all of these uses in mind. As a result, our gazebos have become the choice of homeowners and exterior design

With a gently curved roof and an attractive cupola, the Monterey Classic is a timeless design. Its clean lines blend well with all architectural styles.






Our spacious San Cristobal Garden House is a solid western red cedar structure beautifully designed for year-round use. It is ideal as an


