

The DATORR Workshop will be held February 15-16, 1999 in Tech Area 5, Building 6585, Auditorium. You will receive your visitor badge in Building 6585. We will have coffee and bagels available at 8:30, and the meeting will start at 9:00. See you there!

#### Directions to Tech Area 5:

To expedite your entry onto Kirtland AFB, your Sandia host will call the gate to inform the guards you will be arriving and an approximate time. When you arrive at the gate, please have the name and phone number of Sandia host, as the guard may call that person before you are allowed to enter the base. Sandia host: Judy Beiriger (505) 844-8050.

If you are coming from the AmeriSuites hotel in the Uptown area, go south on Louisiana to Gibson and turn left onto Kirtland AFB. There are two left turn lanes, so you should be in the rightmost of the left turn lanes. If you are staying elsewhere, enter at either the Gibson gate (from your hotel, get to Louisiana and head south or to Gibson and head east) or the Wyoming gate (from your hotel, get to Wyoming and head south).

If you drive onto the base, bear to the right and pull into the parking area. Stop, exit your vehicle, and enter the guard house. You must present the following documents to get an admittance pass for your vehicle:

- valid driver's license
- proof of auto insurance or rental car agreement
- current vehicle registration or rental car agreement

If you take a taxi, the driver must stop at the gate, and you will be asked to present a picture ID, and state your business and destination. The meeting facility is remote from the main Sandia area, so a rental car may be preferable.

If you enter the Gibson Gate, continue east to Pennsylvania Ave. Turn south (right) onto Pennsylvania. Stay on Pennsylvania as it bends to the left.

If you enter the Wyoming gate, continue south until Wyoming ends at a diagonal cross street, which is Pennsylvania. It may look like Wyoming continues, but that is just a short access road to an Air Force facility. Turn southeast (left) onto Pennsylvania. Pass Wyoming.

Once you are on Pennsylvania heading southeast, you will pass a shooting range, a bridge over an arroyo, a cross street, a golf course, and the base stables. Directly opposite the entrance to the base stables turn right. Once you turn, there will be a few trees on either side of the road and a sign for Sandia National Laboratories Tech Areas 3 and 5. Follow the road back until you get to parking lot. There are fenced areas immediately east and west of the parking lot. The big building on the south side of the parking lot is the meeting facility, Building 6585. Enter the double doors. If you arrive for the start of the meeting, someone will be there to let you in.
